Scene One

[We are in a jungle. It is idyllic. Trees, greenery and mountains surround a small village. There is a temple at the centre and on top is a large tree which branches cover the entire village. There is a sense of celebration and joy amongst the people. The elders stand beside the tree with Kawana. Cue Song 1: Song Of Our Spirit.

ALL

OH WAY OH ... OH OH OH OH OH WAY OH OH WAY OH ... OH OH OH OH OH WAY OH OH WAY OH ... OH OH OH OH OH WAY OH OH WAY OH ... OH OH OH OH OH WAY OH

THIS IS OUR JUNGLE
THIS IS OUR LAND
IT TELLS US OUR HISTORY
LIKE LINES ON OUR HAND
AND ALL THAT SURROUNDS US
IS ONE WITH OUR HEART
TOGETHER UNITED WE ARE

ONE WITH OUR NATURE
ONE WITH OUR KIND
BORNE OF A SPIRIT
AS ONE WE'RE COMBINED
WE LIVE BY THE RIVER
BY MOUNTAINS AND TREES

Neema, they happen every year! I've seen them before.

NEEMA

Stop being a stick in the mud. Come on!

[Kawana comes down from the Tree Temple and approaches Konane.]

KAWANA

Konane!

KONANE

Hello mother.

KAWANA

You promised you wouldn't be late! Where have you been?

NEEMA

She's been with me.

KAWANA

NEEMA - you really need to stop covering for her.

KONANE

But I'm here now!

KAWANA

Yes you are my child. Come. Join us.

[Kawana takes Konane up to the Tree Temple.]

THIS TREE IS OUR PRESENT **OUR FUTURE AND PAST GIVEN BY MYSTERY** TO HER, WE HOLD FAST A CIRCLE UNENDING THAT'S WRAPPED US IN CARE THIS IS THE HOPE THAT WE SHARE

ALL

GOVERN US WISELY

KAWANA

KAWANA OTHERS

...I DO

MY HEART'S FOR THE PEOPLE

AND IS ALWAYS TRUE

SO LET'S STAND UNITED OOH WITH EYES TO SUN OOH AAH

AND LIFT UP OUR VOICES AS ONE

ALL

AS WE SING

KONANE

KONANE

I know it all - I've watched you long enough.

KAWANA

Very well then, speak to the people.

KONANE

Easy.

[Kawana raises her hands.]

KAWANA

My people, the princess wishes to express her thanks to you.

[The villagers look to Konane.]

KONANE

THANK YOU FOR ALL THAT ...

[She can't find the words ... and her mother saves her.]

KAWANA

... YOU GIVE TO OUR HOME

KONANE

AND THANK YOU FOR ALL OF ...

[Again, Konane can't find the words ... this is harder than she thought.]

KAWANA

... OF THE SEEDS THAT YOU'VE SOWN

KONANE

I PROMISE MY PEOPLE ...

[Kawan steps in - they are not Konane's people: yet.]

KAWANA

... BY HER, SHE MEANS WE

KONANE + KAWANA

OUR NATION WILL ALWAYS BE FREE

ALL

SO WE SING

OH WAY OH - THIS IS THE SONG OF OUR SPIRIT

OH WAY OH - THIS IS THE SONG OF OUR SOUL

OH WAY OH - THIS IS THE SONG OF OUR FUTURE

OH WAY OH - THIS IS THE SONG OF US ALL

OH WAY OH - THIS IS THE SONG OF OUR SPIRIT

[The villagers leave.]

KAWANA

Elders - Asante.

ELDERS

Asante, Malkia.

[The elders exit.]

KONANE

Well, that went ...

Interestingly.	KAWANA
Konane, you were great!	NEEMA
Neema, I think she still needs some pra	KAWANA ctise.
Mother, you jumped in just when I was a	KONANE about to say something.
[Slightly mocking] Oh, and here I was th	KAWANA ninking you didn't know what to say!
[Confident.] I had it completely in hand.	KONANE
Perhaps.	KAWANA
NEEMA My Queen, can Konane come to the river?	
Sounds great!	KONANE
No.	KAWANA
Mother!	KONANE
You have your lessons.	KAWANA
Ugh!	KONANE
Maybe later?	NEEMA
Maybe later.	KAWANA
Bye Konane. Kwaheri Malkia Kawana.	NEEMA
Kwaheri Neema.	KAWANA

[Neema exits.]

Konane	KAWANA
I know, I know!	KONANE
You have duties to perform.	KAWANA
I know.	KONANE
And a princess	KAWANA

Well, maybe not everything.	KONANE

KONANE Mother, I didn't say that. You still have many years to live.

	KONANE

Again?

KAWANA

Again. Begin.

[Kawana sits and listens to Konane speak.]

KONANE

[Tiredly] Moja: We are at one with the jungle. We give to the jungle, and the jungle gives to us.

KAWANA

Continue.

KONANE

Mbili: The Tree of the Temple is sacred, and only the Queen may approach it.

[Cue Song 2: Ready Now. We begin to shift into Konane's thoughts.]

KONANE

Tatu: We are to be hidden from others, lest strangers interrupt our way of life. Nne: We are to give ...

MOTHER SAYS THAT I'M NOT READY MOTHER SAYS I HAVE TO LEARN MOTHER SAYS I MUST BE PATIENT BUT I CAN'T 'CAUSE IN ME BURNS A FLAME THAT'S LIKE A HUNGER AND IT'S CLAWING AT MY HEART HOW CAN I WAIT WHEN I WAS BORN TO START?

I KNOW EVERY LAW AND COVENANT I KNOW EVERY RITUAL I HAVE PRACTISED SINCE A CHILD THEY'RE ALMOST ... HABITUAL BUT EVERY TIME I SAY TO MOTHER "I KNOW IT ALL, WHEN IS MY TURN?" SHE SAYS; "EASY CHILD, THERE'S SO MUCH MORE TO LEARN."

BUT I'M READY NOW, I'M STEADY NOW SO WAVE THE FLAG, LET'S GO I'M ABLE NOW TO HAVE THE LABEL NOW AND NOT JUST A CAMEO LET ME SAY THAT WORDS THAT MATTER YOUNG AND OLD, I WILL IMPRESS I'M READY NOW SO MOTHER JUST SAY "YES!"

[We shift back into the real world.]

KONANE

Kumi, the Queen has the final word on all matters of the village.

KAWANA

That's right, I do.

KONANE

Is that my lesson for the day? Can I go to the river now?

KAWANA

Not yet.

KONANE

What?

KAWANA

Come, there's something I need to show you.

[Kawana and Konane approach the Tree of the Temple and sit at its base. The elders enter and gather around the tree.]

KAWANA

This tree is our guide.

KONANE

Yes, yes. I understand. One tree ...
