Scene 1: The Airport Lounge (2pm)

[Joseph and Lisa are sitting in an aeroplane lounge, awaiting their boarding call.]

VOICE OVER:

Ladies and gentlemen, your attention please. Qantas Flight 1266 to Los Angeles has been delayed indefinitely due to mechanical difficulties. Would all passengers please report to the ticketing counter at the main entrance for further details...

JOSEPH

[Groans] Oh, you've got to be kidding me...

[They both sit there. Silence. Joseph continues talking to himself.]

JOSEPH

This is unbelievable!

[More silence.]

JOSEPH

I mean, you think that they'd...

LISA

Arrange another flight?

JOSEPH

[Suddenly realizing someone was listening to him] Yeah...
Yeah, you think they would. What do they care if I miss my meeting? I mean, it's not like I'm depending on this flight

or anything.

LISA

You're not alone there. I'm supposed to be in LA by seven in the morning...

JOSEPH

Yeah? What are you going there for?

LISA

Some hot shot reckons he's got the next big thing in I.T. My company wants to check it out.

JOSEPH

You in computers?

LISA

Gaming.

JOSEPH

Pokies?

LISA

No, virtual reality.

JOSEPH

[Laughs] Man, that's got to be a great job!

LISA

Yeah, sure, if you like late nights, early mornings, away from home, staring at a computer screen sixteen hours a day. And you? What do you do?

JOSEPH

Me?

LISA

Well ... yes.

JOSEPH

Oh! Boring stuff. Nothing as glamorous as computer games. Seriously - very average, non-descript, low paying...

LISA

... doing what?

JOSEPH

I sell Blue Tac.

LISA

[Laughs out loud] Blue Tac? [Composes herself.] Well, I guess you're the guy who holds everything together then!

JOSEPH

Very funny... No, I get to peddle this stuff around the world and sell it for way more than it's worth.

LISA

Sounds familiar. [Pause.] I'm Lisa.

JOSEPH

Joseph - but everyone calls me Joe.

LISA

Average Joe?

JOSEPH

Pretty much.

LISA

Nice to meet you Average Joe.

JOSEPH

You too. [Pause] So, are we going spend the night here or find out what Qantas has in store for us?

LISA

I've slept in way too many airport lounges in my life. Let's go.

JOSEPH

Sounds good.

[They pick up their stuff and leave.]

Scene 1b: The Man's Bedroom (2:30pm)

[The Man is settling into bed, and turns out the light. There's a little silence. We see Caller 1 begin to dial, and then The Man's phone rings. The Man turns on the light and grabs the phone.] THE MAN

Hello?

CALLER 1 (WRONG NUMBER)

Um hi ... I'm looking for Arimus Black.

THE MAN

Sorry, I think you've got the wrong number.

CALLER 1 (WRONG NUMBER)

Really? I'm sure this is the right...

THE MAN

What have you got written down?

CALLER 1 (WRONG NUMBER)

9598 2766.

THE MAN

Sorry, this is 9598 2676.

CALLER 1 (WRONG NUMBER)

Oh. Right. Sorry.

THE MAN

No worries.

[He hangs up the phone, settles back into bed, and turns off the light.]

Scene 2: The Church (3pm)

[The Reverend, Matt and Belinda are out the front of a church, where they have just completed their final practice before their wedding.]

REVEREND

Well! It looks like we're all set for your big day! You must both be extremely excited.

BELINDA

Oh we are; and thank you so much Reverend.

REVEREND

My child, it's a pleasure. It will be a real honour to marry the two of you.

BELINDA

And it will be an honour to be married by you.

REVEREND

Oh, I'm sure. Now, you two have a great night, but early to bed! The day will be full of excitement!

BELINDA

Thank you so much and we'll see you tomorrow!

REVEREND

Bye bye Belinda. Bye Matthew!

[The priest leaves. Cue Song 2: <u>Cold Feet</u>.

Belinda walks out onto the church steps, but Matt is off in his own world.]

BELINDA

HONEY, WHAT'S WRONG? ARE YOU OKAY?

MATT I'M FINE;

I WAS JUST THINKING

BELINDA

THINKING 'BOUT WHAT?

MATT

WELL...

THIS TIME TOMORROW, WE WILL BE MARRIED.

BELINDA

I KNOW -

WE WILL BE HUSBAND AND WIFE BOUND TOGETHER WITH THE TIES OF LOVE FOR THE REST OF OUR LIVES.

MATT
